

Population and Development Data Base System (POPnet)

The National Population and Development Data Base System is a web-based system which enable the user to access information on population and development at national level through web-browser. POPnet was first developed in 2005 and completed in early 2006.

Information available in the POPnet National comprised of seven (7) modules, namely:

- i. Population
- ii. Living Quarters
- iii. Household
- iv. Labour Force
- v. Health
- vi. Education
- vii. Family Planning.

The information displayed are in the form of tables and charts. These information can be edited, printed and transferred into pictorial, text and data. Calculation in terms of percentage, rate and ratio can also be done by the system. Sources of data are from the Department of Statistics and surveys carried out by the Board (NPFDB).

Being user friendly, information from the POPnet can be accessed at faster rate. By only with the touch of your finger, you can access up to date and accurate data at any time and at any place wherever you are.
